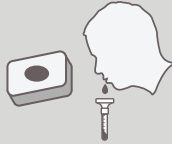


What happens next?

Your physician has ordered a genomic test at the Strand Center for Genomics and Personalized Medicine. We explain *what happens next*.

Sample Collection

- Based on the test requested, we will collect either of these samples:
 - a) **Saliva**
(directly from you)
 - b) **FFPE tumor blocks, or blood**
(from the relevant pathology lab)
- You will review and sign the consent form to perform the test
- Payment will be collected by our sales representative or the treating hospital
- Your sample will be carefully shipped overnight to our Strand Center lab

Sample Processing & Analysis

- Expert scientists at the Strand Centre lab process your sample to decode and analyse information in your DNA
- The first step is to extract adequate and good quality DNA, which can take up to 7 days from sample receipt in our lab
- There is a 1 in 10 chance that your sample may fail quality requirements. In this case, a message will be sent to your physician for resampling
- If resampling is possible, we will repeat the tests at no extra cost for you
- If resampling is not possible, we will cancel the test and return your payment in full

Personalized Genomic Test Report Ready

- A carefully prepared test report with details of the findings will be shared with your physician, to help in deciding the best course of healthcare management for you

Note:

Diagnostic tests from the Strand Center can only be ordered by a physician/licensed medical practitioner.

The Strand Center lab will not perform a test without the consent of the patient or guardian.

Certain tests may require pre and post-test genetic counselling.
